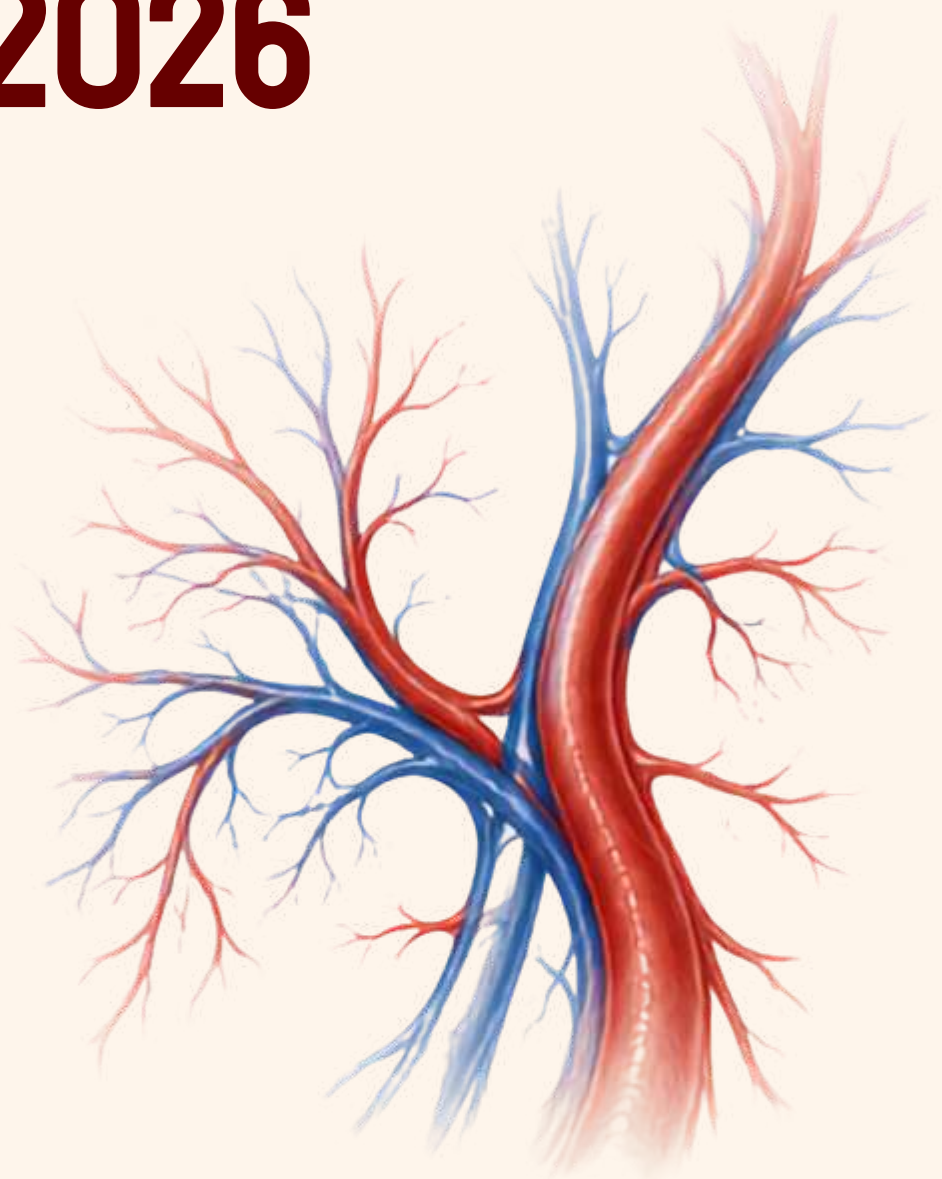
ABOUT INAVASC 2026

We extend our sincere appreciation to all faculty members, speakers, moderators, instructors, participants, sponsors, and partners whose dedication and support have made this event possible.

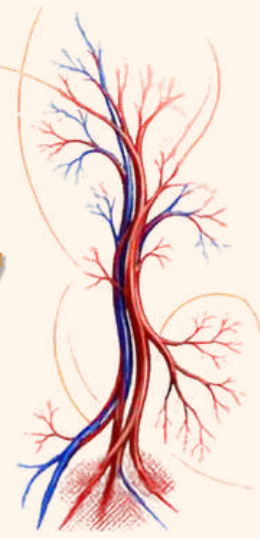

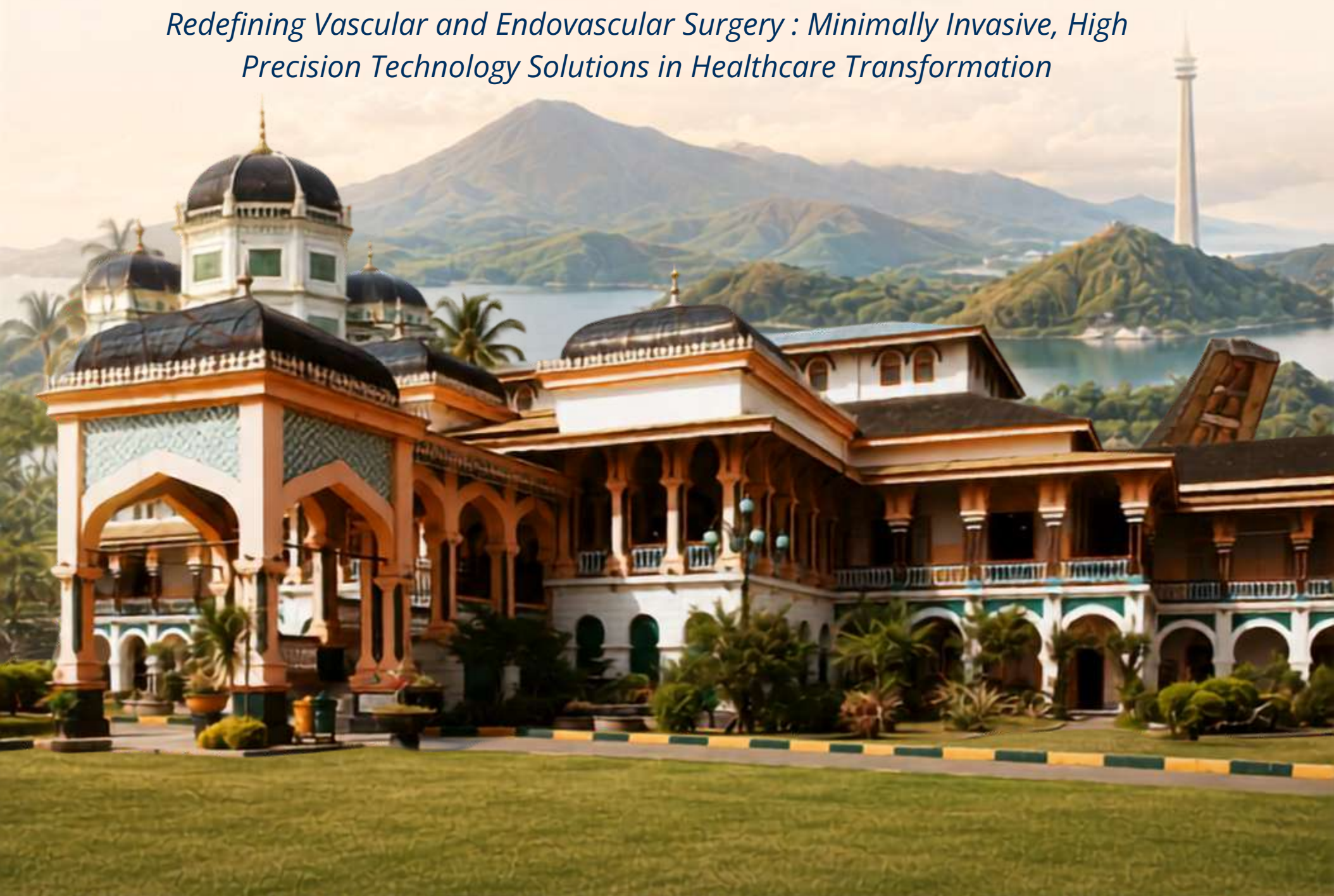
